Our post-holiday food drive is coming to a close. Please be generous! Jenny McElroy will be collecting everything on February 10.

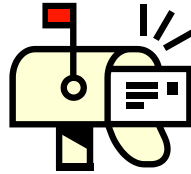
Salary Adjustment Form
