At our May representative meeting, a proposal was made that an increase of \$20 for dues should be recommended commencing next year. We have not had a dues increase since 2000. The vote was counted and 205 members voted yes and 36 members voted no. There will be an increase in your dues commencing next year of less than \$1 per pay period.

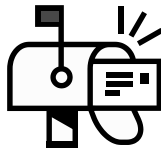
